**Response to CA Executive Order N-33-20 and
County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health Safer at Home Order for Control of
COVID-19 (‘LADPH Order’)**

The Company provides services to the Broadcast industry through the manufacture, supply and support of ‘on air’ infrastructure critical hardware and software and the provision of technical engineering configuration and support services.

The Company’s equipment, software and support services are present in ‘on air’ critical broadcast installations across the US with customers and end users including FOX, NBC, ABC, CNN and many others.

As a result we believe the Company is an Essential Business as defined in the LADPH Order, specifically qualifying under paragraphs 13 (n), 13 (q) and 13 (h) with specific reference to customers and end users who qualify under paragraph 13 (d).

We also believe that given the Company can not carry on its Essential Business without continuation of supply from its own key suppliers, they must also by definition qualify similarly as Essential Businesses.

In addition the Company has reviewed CISA ‘Guidance on the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce’ and believes its workers qualify under the 2nd, 4th, 5th & 7th bullet points under communications and the 3rd bullet point under Information Technology. In recent days our support engineers have been engaged with supporting broadcast employees with efforts to configure and set-up their own ability to work remotely from home in addition to their normal work supporting broadcast installations.

Furthermore the Company has only 10 employees employed at its Northridge, CA location and has taken steps to ensure that not all employees should ever be present at the office at any one time.



All employees who can are being encouraged to work from home and only visit the office if it is absolutely essential. The Company has made the provision of equipment and technology to enable more home working a priority.


All employees are aware of the correct Social Distancing protocols and there are adequate stocks of soap and sufficient handwashing facilities throughout the building.
